Doubting Thomas

Thomas the Twin, one of Jesus' disciples, has gone down in history as 'Doubting Thomas'. But is that really fair? He was no more 'doubting' than

the other disciples were before they'd met the risen Christ, and probably no worse than the rest of us.

Calling him 'Doubting Thomas' seems even more unfair when we remember that he didn't *stay* doubting. His were honest doubts and he was genuinely seeking the truth that he then found.

Having doubts need not be a

problem, but being stuck with them definitely can be. If Thomas had had a closed mind, with doubts motivated by cynicism or rejection, then perhaps he would have deserved the name *Doubting* Thomas. But doubts can be part of a process that brings a deeper conviction and understanding. Thomas went from doubting to trusting and then declaring, "My Lord and my God!" The challenge for each of us is: Do I stay with the doubts? Or do I use them to motivate me to seek the truth?

May we each seek that which leads us to the truth that Thomas found as he met the risen Christ, and like him declare with a new understanding and conviction, "My Lord and my God!"


