### **Serving Others**

The apostle Peter is fondly remembered for his mistakes. He's gone down in history for stepping out of the boat and sinking, for being rebuked by Jesus, who told him to "Get behind me, Satan!", and for denying Jesus three times

right after swearing he'd never do such a thing.

It does seem unfair that Peter should be singled out. After all, Thomas is known as 'Doubting Thomas'; Philip, when faced with 5000 people to feed did the maths and declared it impossible; all the disciples fell asleep in Gethsemane; tragically, Judas made the ultimate mistake of betraying Jesus for 30 pieces of silver, and today, in our Gospel reading, James and John get it wrong by asking if they could be seated with Jesus 'in glory'.



It's not just the disciples who got things wrong, though. In reality, we can *all* get it wrong. Every time our actions are motivated by self-promotion and a desire for status, Jesus, in His answer to James and John, is speaking to us too.

Leadership in God's kingdom is exercised by becoming a "servant of all". Jesus's followers are called to prioritise the needs of others above their own ambitions. True greatness in God's eyes is found not in positions of power, but in following the example of Christ himself, who came "not to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." 
